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## PRESS RELEASE

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### BELOPOLSKY SWEEPS FRAMINGHAM SUMMER GRAND PRIX

Boris Belopolsky of Brookline scored four straight wins to outdistance a formidable field in the 2nd West Suburban Summer Grand Prix in Framingham, June 15-16. Ilya Gurevich of Worcester took clear second with a  $3\frac{1}{2}$ - $\frac{1}{2}$  score, conceding only a draw with Patrick Wolff of Belmont. Alan Shaw of Somerville and Carl Stutz of Acton each had an excellent weekend and finished 3-1 to share third place; Stutz won the additional honor of First Under 2200.

The chief casualty of the first round was top-seeded Jim Rizzitano of Sharon who was held to a draw by Thomas Provost of Cambridge; Rizzitano withdrew after another draw in the second round (with Yuly Kolodkin of Brookline). Gurevich and Wolff drew their second-round game, while Shaw upset Massachusetts Champion John Curdo, who was also having a disappointing weekend. Belopolsky knocked off co-leader Shaw in the third round to take sole possession of the lead. The crucial final-round match-ups were Wolff-Belopolsky and Curdo-Gurevich, and both turned into cliffhangers. Curdo's game eroded steadily through the middlegame, and after making the time control by seconds, resigned the minor-piece ending, two pawns down. Wolff developed an edge against Belopolsky, but both players had to make their last 20 moves in less than three minutes, and in the blitz game that developed, Wolff dropped two pieces, leaving Belopolsky with a well-deserved first-place victory.

In other sections, Russell Gouveia of Peterborough NH and Vesna Dimitrijevic of Cambridge drew quickly in the final round to share first in the Premier (Under 2100) Section,  $3\frac{1}{2}$ - $\frac{1}{2}$ , with David McKee of Wellesley and Phillip Gerstein of Somerville equal third a half-point back. Mark Wegner of Providence RI compiled the only other perfect score of the tournament to win the Amateur (Under 1750) Section, a full point ahead of his pursuers. A triple tie for first developed in the Reserve (Under 1400) Section between Mark Steinberg of Framingham, Vincent Cammarano of Revere, and Steven Tseki of Marblehead.

A special best-played game award went to Patrick Wolff for his first-round win over Carl Stutz, with honorable mentions to Belopolsky, Shaw, and Gary Nute of Nashua NH.

Tournament vignettes: Reserve Section co-winner Mark Steinberg's biggest problem on the weekend was fitting his son's entire soccer game in between the first and second rounds...Boris Belopolsky relieved the tension of his final-round game against Wolff by going out to the bar to play Pac-Man when it was Wolff's move...Lee Denis demonstrated an even more relaxed attitude by letting his clock run for 35 minutes at the start of Round 4, because he couldn't tear himself away from the games of double-bug-house in the analysis area...Vesna Dimitrijevic scored  $1\frac{1}{2}$  points on Sunday to share first in her section by playing only 15 moves--a 9-move win and a 6-move draw.

Warren Pinches directed the 85-player field for the sponsoring Framingham Chess Club, with some assistance from Tom Zuppa and George Mirijanian. The next major Framingham event will be the 3rd Annual Framingham Open, September 28-29.
